Dear Ms. Illi:

On May 15, 2013, Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) submitted a letter response to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) comment letter on the 2012 Annual Monitoring report dated April 15, 2013. The CRA letter was submitted on behalf of Reynolds Metals Company and Whirlpool Corporation, the Responsible Parties for the Highway 96 Dump Superfund site (Site).

MPCA staff has reviewed CRA's response letter. Responses to MPCA comments 1, 3, 4 and 5 are acceptable to the MPCA.

Regarding the response to MPCA comment #2 pertaining to landfill gas, Superfund program staff consulted with MPCA Closed Landfill program staff. The MPCA has determined that no additional gas venting is necessary at the Site.

The MPCA agrees with the response to comment #6. A meeting between CRA and MPCA should be set-up to discuss the status of the Post Closure Operation and Maintenance Plan.

In regards to comment #7, it should be noted that on June 3, 2013 the MPCA received comments from the city of North Oaks' consultant, suggesting changes to the long-term monitoring program. Therefore, as with the Post Closure Operation and Maintenance Plan, the MPCA would like to review and discuss the long-term monitoring program with CRA.
