Mayor and Council Members-

Below is an update on key activities during the past month.

Replacement Well at 12 West Shore Road

MPCA and MDH are still working on proper abandonment of the original (basement) well. According to an update received from MPCA earlier this week, they hope to have the issue resolved by the end of the month. Installation of the replacement well is on hold until the original (basement) well abandonment is resolved.

Groundwater Monitoring

The October round of well testing was completed and the results were sent to Mayor Schaaf today by CRA. Vinyl chloride was detected below the MDH Health Risk Limit (HRL) in samples collected from 10 West Shore Road and 15 West Shore Road. Vinyl chloride has been detected (below the HRL) at these locations during previous sampling events. Vinyl chloride was NOT detected in any of the other residential well samples collected in October 2009. The results will be posted on the City webpage (as has been done in the past). The next scheduled round of testing will be in April.
